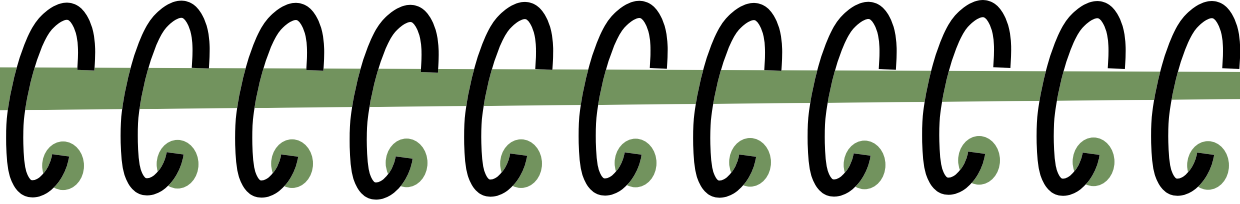

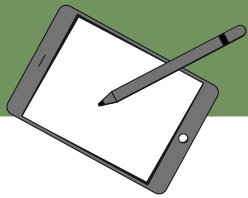

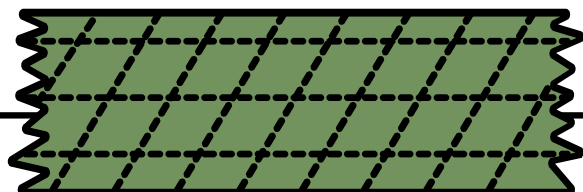

# Reimbursement Conditions

Participants must take part in all activities of the TC from March 26th - April 1th, 2025 (Working days). **Should arrive to Cerro Muriano between 16:00 a.m. - 20:00 pm on March 26th and should leave Cerro Muriano before 11 am on April 1st.**

## PROVIDING ORIGINAL TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

In order to be reimbursed participant has to provide all evidences of travelling: ORIGINAL train/bus tickets, boarding passes, invoices, etc., as well as the evidence of payment (e.g. bank transcript of payment).

# Reimbursement Conditions



## **ERASMUS FINAL REPORT FROM THE EUROPEAN UNION**

This survey is mandatory and must be completed by each participant after the Training Course and it's the only way we can finalize the Final Report.

Usually it arrives from this mail **EU-CORPORATE-NOTIFICATION-SYSTEM@ec.europa.eu-**

It won't take you more than 5 minutes. If you have any questions about that, do not hesitate to contact us.

**DISSEMINATION** is important for our project and it's an effort of all of us. You should send us the links of the visibility you made through your website, social media, local newspapers, etc. Publications must include the word ERASMUS+ and the logo.

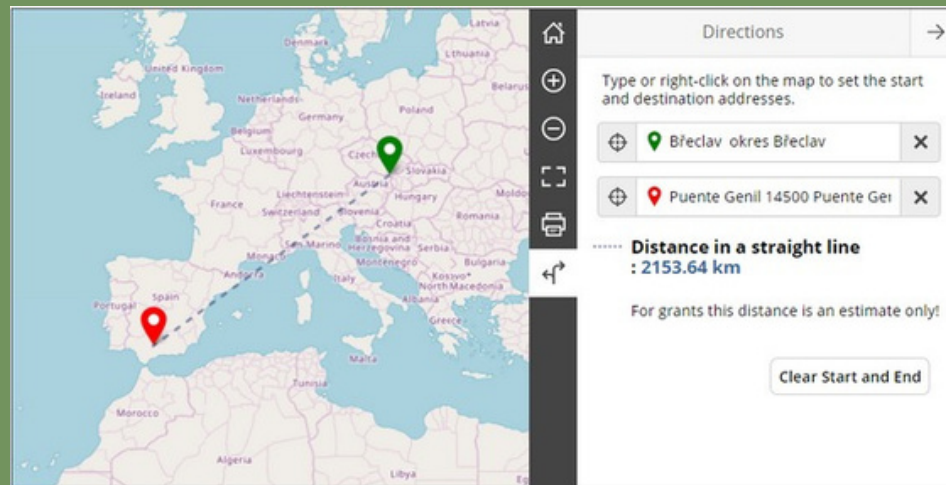
\*Finally, when the indicated actions have been carried out, we will send your NGO the travel cost calculation and proceed with the bank transfer to the NGO corresponding to your travel expenses.



# Reimbursement Conditions

To calculate your eligibility for the maximum amount of reimbursement you can receive, please refer to the [Erasmus+ Distance Calculator](#).

- Insert the location of your organization (city) and the final destination, **Cerro Muriano**.



- Then apply the distance in kilometers to the following table, and you will see how much money you can possibly receive for your travel reimbursement for one person.

Travel distance	Green travel	Non-Green travel
10 – 99 km	56 EUR	28 EUR
100 – 499 km	285 EUR	211 EUR
500 – 1999 km	417 EUR	309 EUR
2000 – 2999 km	535 EUR	395 EUR

## **Important Information to Take into Account**

Following the guidelines of the Erasmus+ / YIA Program and internal regulations, the travel must be released by the participants on the direct way within maximum 2 days. In case of long pauses or indirect routes (holiday travel), there is no reimbursement of travel costs!



**\*NOTE** that, except illnesses, you are expected to participate FULLY in all activities.

- Unauthorized absence from activities and workshops is not permitted. If less than 90% of the program is attended, it will not be possible to be reimbursed for the travel costs.
- Missing or lost tickets will not be reimbursed. Taxi or petrol costs are not reimbursed (ask us before if you would need it).
- ORIGINAL Boarding passes for all the parts of air- travel are essential for reimbursement.
- "Booking paper" alone is not enough (invoices are required). The documents must be uploaded in original PDF (screenshots are not allowed!).

**\*TIP:** If you are selected and your flight tickets are approved by us, purchase your tickets directly from the airline's website to ensure you receive original boarding passes and invoices. When purchasing through a phone app, obtaining these documents can be much more complicated.



## Travel Instructions

The nearest airports to Córdoba are Malaga and Sevilla, but you could also choose Madrid. Before purchasing your flight tickets, please consider the following information based on the airport you arrive at.

### ***If you land at Sevilla Airport:***

#### Option **BUS**:

You can take a city bus (**TUSSAM**) from the airport to the Bus Station "Plaza Armas"

And here you can take a bus to Córdoba Bus Station (**ALSA**)

### Option **Train** (Renfe):

You can take a city bus (TUSSAM) to Sevilla-Santa Justa train station

Where you can take a train to Córdoba

### ***If you land at Malaga Airport:***

#### Option **BUS**:

You can take a city bus (**EMT**) from the airport to the Malaga Bus Station

And here you can take a bus to Córdoba Bus Station (**ALSA**)

### Option **Train** (Renfe):

Take a Cercanías train (in front of arrivals) called Renfe which will take you to Central Train Station Málaga María Zambrano.

ARRIVALS



***If you land at Madrid-Barajas Airport:***

To go from Madrid airport to Atocha train station, it is advisable to take the express bus 203.

Option Bus (**Socibus**): You can take a bus or metro to Estación Sur bus station where you can take a bus to Cordoba.

Option Train :You can take a bus or metro to Atocha Train Station where you can take a train directly to Cordoba .

## Lane N - Linea N

Now you are at the most important stage of your journey. You are at the Córdoba bus or train station, which are in the same place. Right in front, there is a City Bus stop that takes you directly to Cerro Muriano Pueblo (not the military base).
